## WINTER ESSENTIALS

## **Items Needed:**

- Travel-size toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap/body wash, lotion, washcloth, comb, etc.)
- Non-perishable food/snacks (Nutrigrain bars, applesauce pouches, crackers, individual peanut butter cups,)
  - Warm socks, hat, gloves, scarves, etc.
- Hand/foot warmers
- Pocket-size tissue pack, fever-reducing tablet pack
- Mask & hand sanitizer (travel size)
- Reusable grocery bags/totes to hold items
- Garbage bags to keep belongings dry
- 211 card and note of support/encouragement (optional)
- Optional items to consider umbrellas, pet food, underwear, shoes, feminine hygiene products, lip balm
